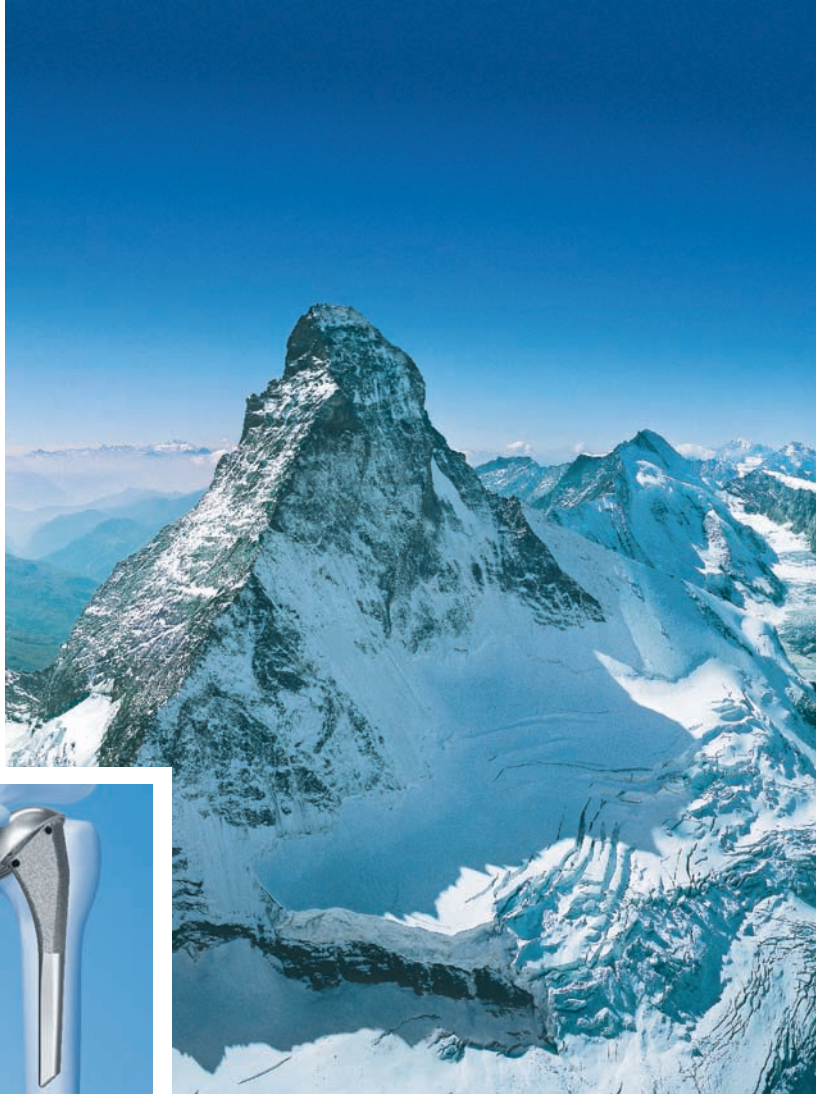


12 month Fellowship Shoulder and Elbow Surgery
