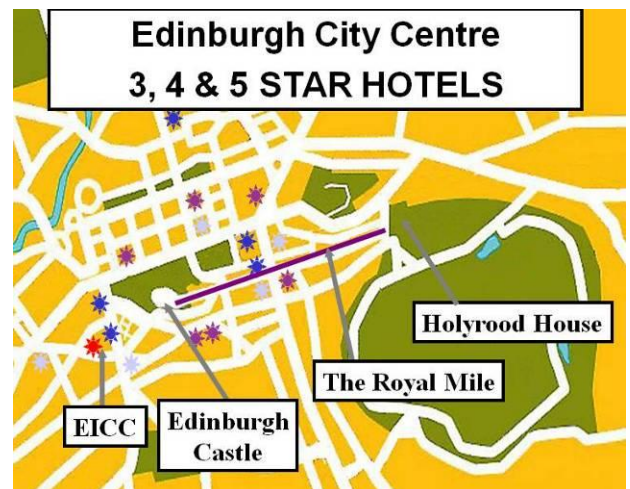
1) Timelines

- **01 February 2010** – Abstracts Open at www.iceses2010.com
- **February 2010** – Early Registration commences
- **19 March 2010** - Deadline for Abstract Submission
- **March/April 2010** - Abstracts scored
- **9th April 2010** – Completion of Abstract rating by assessors
- **16th to 20th April 2010** – Email of acceptance/rejection of abstracts to presenters
- **1st June** – Early Registration Deadline
- **1st July** – Deadline for booking guaranteed hotel accommodation
- **Week Beginning 30th August 2010** – Optional Clinical Visits for surgeons and therapists to UK Shoulder & Elbow Centres
- **2nd September 2010** – ICSES Ryder Cup competition starts and other golfing events
- **4th September 2010** – For SECEC Members – SECEC Dinner in the evening
- **5th September 2010** – 14.00 Start of the ICSES2010 Congress
- **8th September 2010** – 17.00 End of the ICSES2010 Congress

2) Booking your Hotel accommodation for the ICSES 2010

The hugely popular Edinburgh International Festival ends on 4th September 2010 and the closing Military Tattoo is also on Saturday 4th September (see www.edinburghfestivals.co.uk/). Those attending should consider coming prior to the ICSES2010 Congress, including the last days of the International Festival. However more importantly, hotel accommodation in Edinburgh during the week from Monday 30th August to Saturday 4th September is at a premium – accommodation will need to be booked for this week well in advance and will be expensive unless you plan to book in to “Economy” hotels. Those who have already decided to come to Edinburgh during the week before ICSES 2010 should consider making their hotel bookings early i.e. now, to avoid disappointment. 5) The 3rd International Congress of Shoulder & Elbow Therapists (3rd ICSET) - Martin Scott, Chair ICSET2010

The 3rd ICSET will run parallel with the ICSES programme, with synchronised timetables and open access between both the conferences and the combined social programme. The organisers Martin Scott (UK), John Basti (USA) and Jo Gibson (UK) have prepared an exciting programme. First the European Society for Shoulder & Elbow Rehabilitation (EUSSE) will run a Symposium on Rotator Cuff Rehabilitation. The ICSET will then have sessions on case studies, free papers and presentations from international researchers and invited speakers who will speak on topics including: the elbow, scapular dyskinesia, the kinetic chain, manual therapy, EMG evidence and rehab, neurovascular problems and pain. The ICSET programme will include a number of CCTV sessions linked with the ICSES programme. Abstract submissions (including case studies) will be invited through the same system as the surgical conference with the same timeline (see 1 above).
